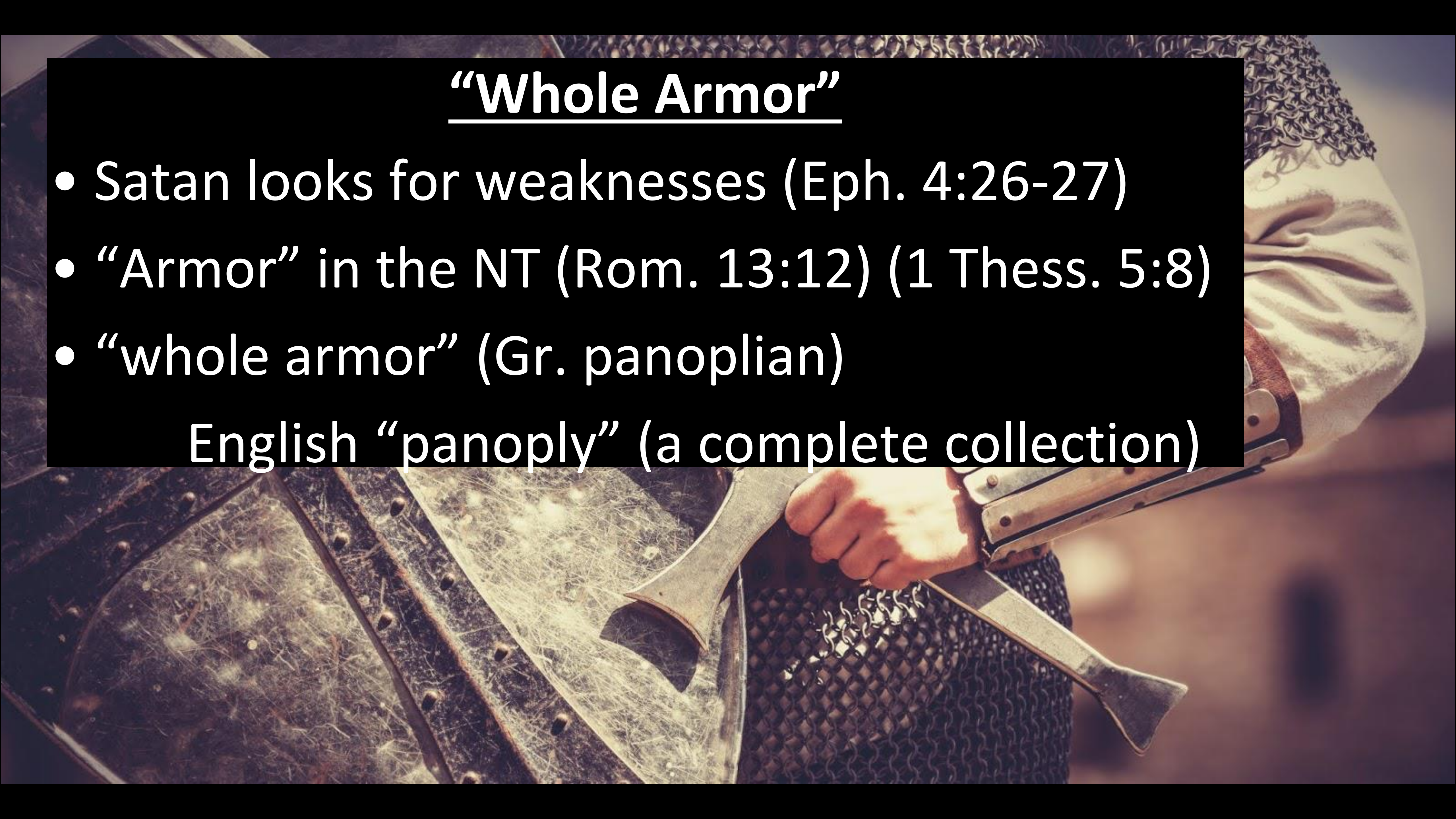

- Satan looks for weaknesses (Eph. 4:26-27)
- “Armor” in the NT (Rom. 13:12) (1 Thess. 5:8)
- “whole armor” (Gr. panoplian)
English “panoply” (a complete collection)

- The “girdle” holds everything together
- It provides Soundness & Readiness (Luke 12:35-37)
- Truth (Psalm 51:6) (1 Peter 1:13)
- Righteousness, Moral Uprightness, Holiness, Goodness, Character (Rom. 6:13)(1 John 2:29; 3:7)
